Registered cover with scarce manuscript "101" indicating very early registration use. Cover to England has blue crayon cross marks denoting registration. Backstamped in red with 22 SP 28 receiving mark in registration office. Very desirable cover. MB= \$50.00.
- Lot 2:** 1930 New Zealand Postal Agency cover to Auckland, New Zealand with 1d New Zealand stamp and "17 JY 30" cds. Cover has been folded twice vertically, but postmark and stamp unaffected. Nice early cover. MB= \$25.00.
- Lot 3:** Beautiful 1937 one-of-a-kind cover to New Zealand. Cover has 1d red Coronation stamp and New Zealand Postal Agency cds "28 JU 37." The cover is signed in pen "Richard Edgar Christian Postmaster." What makes the cover unique is a black and white photograph attached where a cachet usually is on left showing a Pitcairn longboat with men rowing. It is marked in blue manuscript, "Pitcairn's row boat." Unique. Addressed to Captain T.V. Roberts of the RMS *Arawa*. MB= \$75.00.
- Lot 4:** Unaddressed cacheted cover from Schooner *Cornucopia* expedition to Pitcairn, 1984. Cachet in black showing island, rendering of early settlers. Pitcairn 9¢ fish stamp canceled with cds dated "MR 11 84." Clean cover; EST= \$5.00.
- Lot 5:** Unaddressed FDC of 1968 International Human Rights year with set of 3 Pitcairn stamps, cds "4 MR 68"; EST= \$5.00.
