Lots of material including numerous original documents from Pitcairn including a "License to Land and Reside" on the island as well as an original "Marcogram" from Pitcairn to Walker on the HMS *Rangitane* while she was en route to the island. **LOT 2:** Interesting collection of *Pitcairn Miscellany* from 1960 to 1996. Excellent resource for those interested in learning Pitcairn history from the source! A total of 32 issues with tons of articles! Need a home! EST: \$5.00+

**LOT 3:** Original handicraft, quite scarce! Unique hand-painted Hattie leaf mounted on cardboard, 8.5 x 10 inches, beautiful colorful design showing flowers in full bloom with hand-written inscription, "Conveying kind thoughts from across the sea / Pitcairn Island." EST: \$10.00?

**LOT 4:** Do you like Pitcairn stamp varieties? Here is a lot of 12 mint and one used (total of 13) copies of Scott #191a, the 1979 Christmas souvenir sheet. Total Scott's value is \$18.20. EST: \$5.00+
