LOT 1: The collection described on pages 7-8 from Rev. Nelson A.L. Weller is housed in seven, three or four inch, three ring binders. It contains all Pitcairn issues from beginning through 2023, both mint and used (mostly CTO), all souvenir sheets and first day covers. It also contains most of a 98 page exhibit and has all booklets as well as a few specialty items. The mint and used stamps are mounted on hingeless Seven Seas pages. The exhibit is mounted on 8.5 x 11 inch pages printed with the words "Pitcairn Island Stamps" and encased in plastic envelopes. There are a number of error stamps of different kinds as well as some pre-issue items, censored mail from the 1939-1945 era and regular mail items from different periods and locations, to and from PI. LOT 2: Unchecked for varieties! A total of 11 sets of the elusive 1949 Silver Wedding issue, Scott's #11-12. All appear to be very lightly hinged and in pristine condition. Very seldom seen in quantity! Total Scott's catalogue is \$489.50. Very desirable lot for adding to one's personal collection and/or trading. EST: \$75.00 ++

LOT 3: Same as Lot 2, but another 11 sets from a specialist's collection. Total Scott's catalogue value is \$489.50 and it's yours for any reasonable offer. EST: \$75.00++

LOT 4: Here's a nice collection of Scott's #177, the Coronation souvenir sheet. The collection contains 25 "regular sheets," 16 with the "scratch" variety, two used, two used with scratch variety, four with inverted watermarks. Total Scott's catalogue value is \$64.90. EST: \$10.00+

LOT 5: Another lot great for possible varieties or to sell or trade. It's Scott's #192, the London 1980 souvenir sheet, unchecked for varieties. There are 54 sheets, great for trading, etc. Total Scott's CV is \$67.50. EST: \$10.00+

LOT 6: Scott #156-159, American Bicentennial issue, two full sheets of 30 PLUS partial sheets, all MNH. Very clean and excellent for trading, etc. CV= \$158.55. EST: \$25.00++

LOT 7: Scott #184-187, engravings issue, full sheets USED including selvage. Rarely seen! CV= \$28.75. Great for display, etc., EST: \$5.00+

LOT 8: Pitcairn #182-183, MNH, 150th anniversary of death of John Adams, 30 GUTTER PAIRS, rarely seen. CV+ \$18.00. EST: \$5.00

LOT 9: Pitcairn #188-191 (Christmas 1979), MNH, sheets of 25 PLUS row of five above gutter, creating gutter pairs. Unusual! Total Scott's CV is \$37.50. EST: \$5.00+

LOT 10: Pitcairn #181-191 (Christmas 1979) USED sheets of 25 plus plate blocks of 10 from top and bottom two rows of the sheet. Total of 35 used sets great for resale or trading! CV= \$47.50. EST: \$7.50.

LOT 11: Here's something rarely seen and would make a wonderful display for the stamp den. It's a FULL SHEET of 60 of Scott's #39 (1/2d Longboat), MNH. CV= \$15.00. Ought to be worth: EST: \$5.00+

LOT 12: Here is a small collection of early issues of the *Pitcairn Log*, 1982-1991 in two 7 x 9.5 inch green binders with PISG logo in silver on spine. Great reading! Please give these journals a home! EST: \$5.00++

LOT 14: A large handful of older U.S. in glassines, each with Scott number and catalogue value from 2024 (higher now?). Mint and used, Scott's #323 to #2419. Total 2024 CV is \$983.45. This lot needs a home! EST: \$50.00++?

LOT 15: Nice assortment of about 75 worldwide FDCs, all cacheted, mainly 1970s-1990s era, clean and very collectible. Includes Cayman Islands, Bermuda, U.K. Tuvalu, Seychelles, Jamaica, Jersey, etc. ... EST: \$25.00+?

LOT 16: Not Pitcairn, but an interesting 1860s(?) U.S. cover with contents from Greencastle, New Jersey to Trenton, New Jersey. Nice postmark and "PAID" straightline cancel. Four page handwritten letter. EST: \$5.00+?
